## MAJOR DECISIONS OF COUNCIL

The $249^{\text {th }}$ (special) meeting of Council considered the report of the Committee for Rationalisation of Academic, Registrar and Finance Department and approved the following for implementation:

## A. STATUS OF ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ART AND BUILT ENVIRONMENT

i. The Departments of Integrated Rural Art and Industry and Industrial Art should be merged;
ii. The status quo for the existing Faculties (Faculty of Art and Faculty of Built Environment) should remain.

## B. STATUS OF DEPARTMENTS/FACULTIES IN THE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES

i. The College of Agriculture and Natural Resources should have two (2) Faculties namely;

- Faculty of Agriculture
- Faculty of Renewable Natural Resources
ii. The Faculty of Forest Resources Technology is to be converted into a Department under the Faculty of Renewable Natural Resources and run the underlisted programmes:
- Land Reclamation \& Rehabilitation
- Wood Processing \& Marketing
- Ecotourism \& Forest Recreation
- Social Forestry


## C. STATUS OF DEPARTMENTS/SCHOOLS IN THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES

i. The Departments of Medical Laboratory Technology and Medical Imaging should be merged into one Department to be named as the DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAL DIAGNOSTICS.
ii. The Department of Medical Diagnostics will host two (2) Programmes, namely BSc Medical Laboratory Technology and BSc Medical Imaging Technology.
iii. The status quo of the School of Veterinary Medicine will be maintained for one academic year within which the following are to be adhered to:

- The status of Heads of Departments in the School is to be changed to Coordinators;
- Within the 2018/2019 Academic Year, the Dean is mandated to seek funding and collaboration to support the growth and Development of the School.


## D. STATUS OF SCHOOL OF MEDICAL SCIENCES AND DENTAL SCHOOL

i. The School of Dentistry to be merged with the School of Medical Sciences and renamed as SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY

## E. ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW DEPARTMENT

i. The following Programmes (BSc Statistics, Actuarial Science and Mathematics) should continue to run under the Department of Mathematics for the 2018/2019 Academic Year.
ii. At the commencement of the 2019/2020 Academic year, BSc Actuarial Science and BSc Statistics will be weaned off and merged to become an independent Department
iii. BSc Environmental Science will continue to be nurtured by the Department of Theoretical and Applied Biology for the 2018/2019 Academic Year and will be weaned off to become an independent Department at the commencement of the 2019/2020 Academic Year.

## ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATION ENGINEERING IN THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING

i. With effect from the 2019/2020 Academic Year, the Telecommunication Programme should be weaned off the Department of Electrical/Electronic Engineering and be made an independent Department to be called the Department of Telecommunication Engineering.
ii. The College should therefore set up the necessary structures required, including funding for a smooth take off of the Department in the 2019/2020 Academic Year.
