

## COUNCIL DECISIONS

The following decisions, which were taken by the 155<sup>th</sup> meeting of the University Council held on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 1997, are published for the information of the University Community.

### 1. Appointments

Prof. N.K. Kumapley was appointed Dean of the School of Engineering with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1997, to end on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 1998 - the date on which he would retire compulsorily from the service of the University.

### 2. Heads of Departments, Directors of Institutes and Centres

Council approved recommendations from the Academic Board on the appointments of Heads of Departments and Directors of Institutes and Centres, as contained in Appendices 'A' and 'B' attached.

### 3. Promotions

- (a) Council upheld the petition of Prof. Kwame Sarpong for reconsideration of the decision of the University Appointments and Promotions Committee (Senior Members) and decided that he should be promoted to the rank of **Full Professor** in the **Department of Pharmacognosy** with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> **October**, 1992.
- (b) Council also approved the following promotions recommended by the Academic Board (at its 222<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1997):
  - i) Dr. Kofi Sraku-Lartey from Senior Lecturer to Associate Professor in the Department of Mineral Processing and Extractive Metallurgy/Materials Science and Engineering with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1994.
  - (ii) Mr. Foster Llewellyn Adonteng from Senior University Architect to Chief University Architect in the Development Office with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1996.

### 4. Dean of Students

Council endorsed a recommendation of the Academic Board for the appointment of a Dean of Students on the following modalities and terms:

#### Functions

- (i) The Dean of Students shall be responsible for the welfare and discipline of students outside their Halls of Residence.

- (ii) He shall be a member of the Residence Committee to which he shall report periodically. To enable him to have first hand knowledge of decisions of matters affecting the welfare or discipline of students, he shall also be an ex-officio member of the following Boards/ Committees of the University.
- a. Academic Board;
  - b. Welfare Services Board ; and
  - c. Executive Committee

### **Eligibility**

- (i). The Dean of students shall be an academic not lower than the rank of an Associate Professor
- (ii). His appointment shall be supernumerary and he shall continue to hold down at the same time teaching and research duties in his Department.
- (iii). He shall have served the University for not less than five years.
- (iv). He shall not hold any office in a Hall of Residence, or serve on a Council or any Board or Committee in a student Hall of Residence. At any rate, he shall resign from any such service before assuming office as Dean.

### **Appointing Authority**

- (i). The Dean shall be appointed by Council on the recommendation of the Academic Board. He shall however, act on behalf of the Vice - Chancellor to whom he shall report any decisions on a serious breach of discipline for his approval.

### **Procedure for Appointment**

The appointment procedure shall be the same as obtains for the Dean of the Board of Postgraduate Studies as follows:

The Dean of Students shall be appointed by the Council on the recommendation of the Academic Board in Consultation with the Executive Committee.

### **Tenure**

The Dean shall hold office for three years, which may be renewed for a further three year-period. Such renewal shall be made by Council on the recommendation of the Academic Board. The term of Office shall not be renewed a second time.

### **Remuneration**

The Dean shall be entitled to rates of allowances equivalent to those of a Dean of Faculty.

### **Secretarial Staff**

- (i) The Dean shall have an office where students and other interested members of the University community can meet him/her to discuss issues.
- (ii) He shall have a secretarial staff made up of an Assistant Registrar, a Typist-Secretary and a Messenger. He shall work in close collaboration with the Schedule officer in charge of Student Affairs in the Registrar's Department. The office shall be sufficiently equipped to enable the office to discharge its duties promptly and efficiently.

### **5. Establishment of an Institute of Land Management and Development**

In line with the recommendation that the Department of Land Economy and Estate Management and the Land Administration Research Centre (LARC) should merge to form the nucleus of a new Faculty, the Head of the Department had submitted the above proposals to the Academic Board. The Academic Board, at its 222<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1997, accepted the proposal after discussions and recommended it for approval by Council.

The proposal as well as an extract from the minutes of the 222<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Academic Board had been placed before Council.

It was noted that the new Institute would start with two interrelated Units: Teaching/Training and Research with the following focus areas.

- (a) Research
- (b) Documentation
- (c) Dissemination
- (d) Seminars, Conferences and Workshops.

### **New Research Perspectives**

New research areas would include the environment, population, gender and development. The new Institute would also offer postgraduate training up to the PhD level for both Ghanaians and foreigners.

### **Funding**

The Institute's sources of funding would be:

- (a) Government and University sources;
- (b) Collaborative Research and Linkage Sources, both externally and internally;
- (c) Local Consultancy Sources; and
- (d) Continuous Professional Education and Training Sources.

## **Staffing**

The new Institute would draw its staff from a multi-disciplinary full-time, part-time and service lecturers and researchers who had been brought together through the merger of the Department of Land Economy and Estate Management and LARC.

After a brief discussion, Council ratified the proposal for the establishment of an Institute of Land Management and Development in this University.

### **6. Payment of Book and Research Allowances of Staff on Sabbatical Leave**

Council ratified the approval of the Standing and Finance Committee on the following matters which the Committee considered at its 58th meeting held on 15th May, 1997.

#### **(a) Upward Review of the Price of Application Forms for foreign Applicants**

An increase in the price of application forms for foreign students from \$35.00 (US Dollars) a set to \$50.00 (US Dollars) a set.

#### **(b) Payment of Book and Research Allowances to Staff on Sabbatical Leave**

The payment of Book and Research Allowances to staff on Sabbatical Leave with effect from 1st October, 1996.

### **7. Annual Leave for Senior Members**

Council accepted a recommendation by the CVCP to increase the number of leave days for Senior Members to 62 consecutive days per annum, with retrospective effect from 1st March, 1996.

It was noted that the CVCP's recommendation had been prompted by a four-day increase in the leave days for Senior and Junior Staff of the Universities in 1995.

### **8. Scheme of service for SSS Graduates**

Council approved the following recommendation by the CVCP to be inserted in the Scheme of Service for Junior Staff:

**“SSS graduates should have at least grade ‘E’ in three subjects, including English Language and other relevant subjects, plus vocational qualification”.**

The above would take care of appointments of Senior Secondary School (SSS) graduates into Junior Staff (Technical and Non-Technical) grades.

### **9. Free Medical Care for Students and Spouses of Pensioners**

Council approved the following recommendations made by the CVCP at its meeting held on 7th May, 1997.

- “(i) Free medical care should be provided for students at University Hospitals during vacation but should drugs be prescribed to be bought by the patient, no refunds should be expected from the University.  
(ii) Spouses of pensioners could enjoy free medical consultation only at the University Hospitals.”

It was pointed out that since postgraduate students did not enjoy any vacation, refunds would be made for drugs prescribed for them whilst they remained in good academic standing. Attention was also drawn to the fact that Government did not provide the University with funds for drugs.
